

SOLARIG® LIMITED WARRANTY

PIC Plast's SOLARIG® products are covered by the following limited warranties:

1. **PIC PLAST NON-TRANSFERABLE 4 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY GREENHOUSES FOR SOLARIG® ROOF**
2. **PIC PLAST NON-TRANSFERABLE 4 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY FOR SOLARIG® CLASSIC**
3. **PIC PLAST NON-TRANSFERABLE 3 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY FOR SOLARIG® ROOF 182 (In "Chemical environment")**

PIC PLAST guarantees product to be free of defects in materials and workmanship for given warranty period following the original date of purchase. This warranty relates solely to the first installation of the product, provided that it has been precisely executed according to their instructions and is limited only to the product's tensile strength, which should not be less than 50% of the original strength according to the specifications of the company.

This warranty does not include indirect or consequential damage to any person, property or crops, damage caused by force major, accident, misuse, overheating, exposure to or contact with chemicals (i.e., sulfur), which might cause damage to the product according to the installation instructions.

Limited usage with Chemicals. In case of exposure to or contact with chemicals – this warranty will cover only up to 150 ppm of Chlorine (Cl) & up to 1500 of Sulfur (S). If your PIC PLAST product should become defective within the warranty period, we will elect to repair or replace it on a pro-rate Price-List basis, or credit your next purchase from us according to the following terms:

1. Calculate Number of months since delivery of SOLARIG® in months.
2. Calculate Warranty covered period by following formula:

$(\text{Area of SOLARIG®} \times \text{Price List at the exchange date}) \times (\text{No. of Months since delivery/Warranty Months})$

To obtain your warranty rights, please submit your warranty claim(s) to PIC PLAST Ltd. office at 4 HaHashmal, Afula 1810001, ISRAEL:

- 1) A sample of size 1 m x 1 m of defective SOLARIG®
- 2) A copy of the original sales receipt (to establish a date of purchase)
- 3) A summarized statement which includes when/where/how/ and why (your assumption base)

This warranty gives you specific and full legal rights and expresses all the conditions and the scope of the warranty.
